### Eligibility criteria

- » Must be a Communications, Marketing or Public Relations professional actively working in the Miami Valley for no more than 5 year years since earning their undergraduate degree
- OR—
- » A current college student or graduate student studying Marketing, Mass Communications, Public Relations or a related field. Students should be a senior at minimum and have a track record of accomplishment.
- » Nominee does not have to hold an active PRSA or PRSSA membership, though special consideration will be given to those who do.

All nominations must be received by Monday, February 10 at noon. **Late nominations will not be considered.**
